

Your fact sheet is to provide information about who you are, what you have accomplished and your plans. Your fact sheet/CSI essay will tell a lot about you and not in a good way, if you have punctuation errors, misspelled words, or grandiose statements.

Sample Interview Fact Sheet

Current Employment or Schooling: *Name of school, year in school or year of graduation. Also list if in graduate school and include majors. List job/employer if employed.*

Scholastic/Career Ambition: *provide realistic information of your scholastic goals and your career ambition.*

Community Service Initiative (CSI): *Title (Be cautious in using cutesy titles or phrases – there is a difference between a cutesy phrase and an effective catchy phrase, e.g. C.R.O.W.N – Creating Resilient Opportunities for Women Now could be viewed as cutesy but not effective vs S.P.A.R.K. – Service, Purpose, Action, Responsibility & Kindness which could be viewed as catchy and effective.)*

Performance Talent: *What is the talent you will be presenting? (If dance what type, ballet, tap, hip-hop, lyrical, etc. If vocal what is the genre - opera, jazz, pop, country, etc.). Include the title of song or work, include author or composer as applicable.*

Accomplishments:

- *X – Do not mix up sentences and single-word bullet points.*
- *X – To maintain consistency, if you use periods for one item, use them for all items.*
- *X – Please note, if an accomplishment says something like I have played piano since I was 4 or I have been dancing since I was 3, and your talent is something stated in your accomplishments, judges will have higher expectation of your talent to equate to the number of years you have studied in the specific talent presented.*
